NORTHWEST CORNER GOODS sells merchandise that celebrates the Pacific Northwest and Bellingham. The store, which is run by Kevin Misiuda and Bellingham-flag-creator Brad Lockhart, has existed since 2019, but operated primarily online and through consignment and wholesale. The brick-and-mortar store opened in June 2021.

“We talked about retail a lot last year, and it didn’t feel quite right. So, we just felt this year, we got a lot more experience with how our products do and we’ve built out our portfolio,” says Misiuda.

Northwest Corner Goods has a wide variety of PNW-centric goods, from hats and sweaters to flags, patches, pins, bandanas, and art prints.
